This Contract agreement is an exclusive renewable 3 month (per bout) contract, with all terms and conditions contained therein legally binding upon all parties expressly declare themselves freely able, physically and mentally to agree to the contract agreement in its entirety and sign knowing and understanding that by doing so, they commit to adhere to its terms ,in the knowledge that if at any stage during the 84 month period any such term is broken, breached or compromised it will result in legal proceedings being issued, Unless the parties conditioned to it have mutually agreed and signed to dissolve their financial and commercial responsibility of its terms and conditions.

Terms and Conditions

1) This contract is authorised by the Fighter (signed:.....), Knowingly that (he) is exclusive to **IFC-Sport per bout** and certifying that he declares there are no other agreements or contracts either express or implied that he is involved in directly or otherwise, with any other promotion regarding the skills and services that he will be supplying to **IFC-Sport**.

2) The Fighter agrees and authorises that all remuneration monies/fight purses are to be paid directly to him paid by the promoter within 5 days or sooner. Payments are in sterling GBP. Payment will be by an agreed method in a single payment.

3) The Fighter agrees to NOT competing on any other events that do not clash with the event dates within the 3 month period.

4) The fighter is solely responsible for any personal Inland Revenue payments, tax and national insurance contributions where applicable, including completing any forms and administration in relation with any event revenue. The fighter is not employed by **IFC-Sport** and as such no responsibility for these matters will be assumed by **IFC-Sport**

5) **IFC-Sport** will if required, source adequate insurance protection for the fighter for public indemnity and liability purposes for protection outside of the fighting arena for advertising, marketing and or any other events. This insurance premium will be the sole responsibility of the MMA Fighter. Insurance within the combat arena will be provided by the Promoters of the organised events.

6) **The Fighter agrees to maintain his optimum physical fitness and be mentally prepared to participate in a minimum of 1 (one) fights/bouts per 3 (three) month period. Training and physical wellbeing is the sole responsibility of the Fighter.**

7) Any unwarranted behaviour associated with the sport of Mixed Martial Arts will not be tolerated by **IFC-Sport** who aims to provide a moral and ethical working relationship. Any substance abuse leading to disqualification may render the contract void at the discretion of **IFC-Sport**. Any substance abuse/intoxication or failure to adhere to point 14 whether intentional or otherwise that results in a fight being disqualified will render the Fighter liable to a flat administration fee to **IFC-Sport** of £100 (one hundred pounds) OR 20% whichever is the greatest amount, based upon the potential revenue that would have been earned if the bout/fight had taken place.

8) It is the Fighter's sole responsibility to ensure they are able to participate and finance all bouts organised by **IFC-Sport** and have the necessary means to travel to them. Events may be organised within the United Kingdom or abroad and thereby requiring a valid passport. All inability to attend events will be the sole responsibility of the fighter including any financial liability that may be incurred as a result of such losses.

8 A) Any endorsements, disqualifications, convictions or offences whether spent, current or pending or any matters which prevent the Fighter from travelling overseas **MUST** be declared at the time of the contract signing. **FAILURE TO DISCLOSE SUCH MATTERS TO IFC-Sport WILL RENDER THE CONTRACT VOID ON BEHALF OF IFC-Sport AND WILL RELINQUISH ALL IFC-Sport RESPONSIBILITIES.**

8 B) Any unwarranted behaviour which arises in the outcome of 8i) will not be linked in any context with **IFC-Sport** by name, reputation or association.

9) If **IFC-Sport** ceases to trade for any reason whatsoever, all contracts will be void. Any outstanding financial matters will be the sole responsibility of **IFC-Sport**.

10) Any permanent or serious injury resulting in the Fighter no longer being able to participate within the sport associated with Mixed Martial Arts, Boxing or Kickboxing, that renders him incapable of continuing within his professional capacity will dissolve any outstanding terms and conditions contained within this contract, UNLESS the injury sustained can allow the fighter to progress in another mutually agreed capacity.

11) The Fighter agrees not to participate, advertise or promote himself in any activities whatsoever that have not been organised by **IFC-Sport** unless permission is first sought by **IFC-Sport** within the 3 month period

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS OF THE FIGHTER CONCERNING FIGHT AND PRE-MATCH ATTENDANCE



12) **IFC-Sport** expects the Fighter to be completely prepared to participate in the event and to have appropriate clothing including shorts, gloves, groin guard, gum shield and any other equipment necessary to safely enter the fight/bout, ie; bandages, tape etc.

13) **IFC-Sport** requires the Fighter to be in attendance of the specified **event A MINIMUM OF 180 MINUTES PRIOR TO ITS COMMENCEMENT. THIS REQUIREMENT IS MANDATORY, AND WILL ENSURE AVAILABILITY FOR THE RULES MEETING.**

14) The Fighter has ultimate responsibility for registering and attending the '**Rules Meeting**', this is normally scheduled an hour before the commencement of the said event; however it can be open to changes. The Fighter is expected to attend this 'Rules Meeting' to ascertain any changes in the rules/regulation regarding the specific event. **FAILURE to attend the 'Rules Meeting'**, and not be conscious of rule changes that may result in an 'illegal' move being performed that subsequently leads the Fighter to be disqualified will invoke point 7 above and enforce the flat fee 'fine' payable to **IFC-Sport**

15) The 'weigh in' stipulates weight requirement categories, it is imperative that the Fighter attends to ensure this requirement is adhered. The burden is placed upon the Fighter to ensure verification and thereby attend the 'weigh in'. If for any reason the Fighter does not make the correct weight, the onus is placed upon him to correct the discrepancy before the time limit deadline given at the 'weigh in' expires.

16) The Fighter will not object and thereby voluntarily consents to any necessary 'pre-fight' medical examinations, (that are properly conducted) for the safety of both themselves and their opponent.

INCENTIVE SCHEME AND IFC-Sport RESPONSIBILITIES

17) **IFC-Sport** will offer a cash referral incentive to all fighters that are contracted to them for new fighters wanting to participate on future events - details to be discussed in confidence.

18) Optional - **20% flat rate per fight fee**, Alex Reid the appointed Agent/Manager will agree to and be responsible for the following services: sourcing sponsorship, all discussion with promoters, corporate bodies and associated Fight professionals, administration and any other matters connected with activities/events organised by **IFC-Sport**, surrounding the individual Fighters career through to and including reaching the Ultimate Fighting Championship, K1 and or any other high profile event.

19) **IFC-Sport** declares that it will not sell, transfer or assign any interest either wholly or partly associated with the fighter without prior consent and or written agreement.

CLAUSE AND WAIVERS

20) If the Fighter successfully reaches and acquires the capabilities to enter UFC under the guidance and contract of **IFC-Sport** and then chooses to negate his contractor indeed does not renew it due to lucrative remuneration being offered elsewhere by another Agent, Manager, Agent/Manager or Promoter, then a fixed fee will be required to **IFC-Sport**. The fighter has been able to achieve the desired goal in reaching UFC and or K1 standards. This payment will be for a total 25% of the Fighter's first full years remuneration, dividends or any other payment received within the specified timeframe, (twelve month period to commence from the date of the first fight/bout and cease 12 (twelve) months thereafter).

21) **IFC-Sport** will waive any rights or association with the Fighter upon successful receipt of this fixed 25% fee as long as payment is received within 28 days of the last fight taking place.

22) Libellous or Slandorous communications that injure the reputation of **IFC-Sport** and will result in legal proceedings being issued.

Fight purse structure—Fight purse structures are specifically designed for each venue.

For example, if you sell 25 tickets at £40 each (£1000), that's a £150 fight purse + £140 commission, totalling £290 that you will receive. In this example it would be wise to buy an extra ticket yourself, putting you up to 18% commission and a £175 fight purse. $£175 + £180 - £25 = £330.00$

0-5 Tickets per purse £50 commission, 5%

6-10 tickets per purse: £75 commission, 7%

11-15 tickets per purse, £100 commission, 10%

16-20 tickets per purse, £125, commission, 12%

21-25 tickets per purse, £150 commission, 14%

26-30 tickets per purse, £175 commission, 18%

31-35 tickets per purse: £200 commission, 20%

36-40 tickets per purse, £225 commission, 22%

41-60 tickets per purse: £250 commission, 24%

Over 60 tickets purse £300 commission, 26%
